Please read all the contents in this document carefully:

Duty of Care

CPS Football Academy Limited is committed to the safety and well-being of all participants, coaches, and parents/guardians during the Summer Camp. Please read and understand your responsibilities alongside our commitments:

Camp Schedule and Access: The camp will operate daily from 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM. For those purchasing early drop-off access, entry will be available from 9:00 AM. We will conduct daily safety inspections of the facilities to mitigate any potential hazards.

Safety Measures: Safety is our top priority. We will implement rigorous safety protocols, including a comprehensive risk assessment and fire safety procedures (details available upon request).

Nature of Football: Football is a contact sport, which inherently includes a risk of injury. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, you acknowledge the risks associated with participation and that CPS does not take responsibility for any injuries sustained during the camp.

Non-Contact Injuries: Injuries can occur in non-contact scenarios. By agreeing to these terms, you recognize that non-contact injuries are possible and that CPS does not take responsibility for any injuries sustained during the camp.

Anti-Discrimination Policy: We champion equality and do not tolerate discrimination in any form. We reserve the right to refuse entry to any individual found guilty of discriminatory behavior. Individuals dismissed for such reasons will not be eligible for a refund (refer to CPS Refund Policy for details).

Responsibility for Injury Prevention: Parents or guardians must ensure that all children come to the camp with appropriate clothing and protective gear. Players are expected to adhere to safe practices during all camp activities.

Health Disclosure: You must provide all relevant medical information for the participants you register. Failure to disclose crucial health information that results in harm could lead to forfeiture of the right to sue.

Agreement to Terms: By selecting the Terms and Conditions box on our website during registration, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to all the terms outlined above.

Private Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which CPS Football Academy Limited collects, uses, maintains, and discloses information collected from users (each, a "User") of the www.cpsfootballacademy.co.uk website ("Site"). This privacy policy applies solely to information collected through our Site and not to information collected offline.

4. Use of Data

Data collected is used for internal record keeping, improvement of our products/services, and if agreed, to send you marketing communications.

CPS Football Academy Limited's lawful basis for processing your Data includes providing services at your request, fulfilling our contractual obligations, and pursuing our legitimate interests.

5. Data Security

CPS Football Academy Limited employs security measures to protect your Data, such as using secure servers and ensuring data is encrypted where necessary.

You are responsible for keeping your account details confidential.

6. Data Retention

CPS Football Academy Limited retains your Data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes CPS Football Academy Limited collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements.

7. Your Rights

You have rights under data protection laws in relation to your personal data, such as the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data.

Refund Policy

CPS Football Academy Limited is committed to providing high-quality football camps and training sessions. Understanding that unforeseen circumstances can affect plans, we have established the following refund policy to clarify the conditions under which refunds are processed.

Cancellation by CPS Football Academy Limited:

Non-refundable Circumstances: If CPS Football Academy Limited must cancel the camp or specific camp days due to external circumstances beyond our control, including but not limited to severe weather, facility issues, or public safety concerns, no cash refunds will be issued.

Credit Option: In lieu of a cash refund, CPS Football Academy Limited will provide a credit equivalent to the full payment made. This credit is applicable solely towards future coaching sessions or camps conducted by CPS Football Academy Limited.

Cancellation by Participants:

Full Refund Eligibility: Participants may cancel their registration and receive a full refund if the cancellation is made within 3 days of the ticket purchase.

After the 3 day period, cancellations will not be eligible for any refund. CPS Football Academy will offer a credit equivalent up to 50% of the purchase which is applicable solely towards future coaching sessions or camps conducted by CPS Football Academy Limited.

General Terms:

Scope of Policy:

This refund policy is applicable under any circumstances where CPS Football Academy Limited must cancel parts or the entirety of the scheduled camp due to factors outside the reasonable control of the academy.

Financial Commitments:

As substantial financial commitments are made in advance to prepare for the camp, this policy ensures that CPS Football Academy Limited can sustain the quality and delivery of its training programs despite potential disruptions.

Notification: Affected parties will be notified promptly in the event of a cancellation, with explanations provided regarding the specific circumstances and options available.

Media Policy

Definition:

For the purposes of this document, 'Media' refers to photos and videos captured during the camp.

Media Capture and Usage:

Please note that during the camp, CPS Football Academy Limited will capture Media of players engaged in training activities exclusively on the pitch. We assure all participants that no Media will be captured inside changing facilities, adhering strictly to our safeguarding policies.

CPS Football Academy Limited will utilize the Media collected for the following purposes:

- Display on our social media pages.
- Inclusion on our website.
- Use in our marketing materials.

Storage and Privacy:

All Media will be stored securely, following the protocols outlined in our Privacy Policy. Media will be used solely by CPS Football Academy Limited and will not be shared with any third parties without explicit permission from the parents/guardians of the children featured in the specific Media.

Media Team:

Occasionally, CPS Football Academy Limited may engage a professional media team to capture Media during the camp. All Media collected by this third party will be forwarded to us, and their Privacy Policy will be made available to you upon request.

Media Participation:

Due to the nature of the activities and the number of participants, it is impractical to exclude any individual child from Media capture during group activities. Please understand that it is not feasible to guarantee that any child will be absent from the Media collected, as photos and videos often capture multiple participants simultaneously.



Safeguarding Policy

Introduction:
